

## RIGHTS CERTIFICATE

## **GS1 Czech Republic**

- 1. GS1 (formerly called EAN International), is a voluntary, not-for-profit, international association with a Head Office in Brussels, Belgium. GS1 currently has a membership of 108 nationally based Member Organizations. It manages a worldwide, multi-industry standards system enabling the automatic identification of products and services in the supply chain, electronic commerce and global data synchronization. The GS1 standards system uses bar-coding and radio frequency identification technologies.
- GS1 Member Organizations are authorized by GS1 to administer the GS1 System in their own territory and as such are the sole representatives of GS1 for that territory. To ensure the global uniqueness of GS1 identification numbers and the integrity of the GS1 System, there can only be one GS1 Member Organization per national territory.
- 3. GS1 Czech Republic has been a Member Organization of GS1 since 1983. GS1 has granted GS1 Czech Republic an exclusive license to administer the GS1 System in Czech Republic and allocate GS1 identification numbers to companies for their supply chain management needs. It is the sole representative of GS1 in Czech Republic.
- 4. **Trademarks.** By virtue of its membership in GS1, GS1 Czech Republic has the exclusive right to use the 'GS1' trademarks in Czech Republic.
- 5. Copyright rights. GS1 Czech Republic has the exclusive right to copy, translate, reproduce and distribute GS1 publications including the GS1 General Specifications, the GS1 Global User Manual, the GS1 EANCOM manual and other publications published from time to time by GS1. These copyright rights include the right to produce publications that derive from and are compliant with GS1 standards and publications.
